Mac O'Brien is in his second year as a captain for Trent. He earned his second consecutive All Canadian Midfielder and is one the best two way players in the league. He finished second in scoring with 47 points. He is a product of the Peterborough minor lacrosse association and most recently played professionally for the NLL's Chicago

Shamrox.



Josh Wasson earned Honorable Mention as CUFLA's league MVP. Wasson was the league's second highest scorer for 2008, notching 34 goals and 15 assists for 49 points during the regular season. Wasson plays for the Toronto Rock in the NLL, and he also won two Mann Cups ('06, '07) with the

Peterborough Lakers Jr. A team.

CUFLA's Outstanding Goalie for 2008, Calvin Thomas, ended the season with a sparkling 7.5 goals against average. Ranked second in the league, he led his team to the semi-finals of the national championship.
